FOR THOSE SEEKING HOUSING ASSISTANCE

Apply for Rent Geared-to-Income Housing (RGI)

Housing for eligible low-income households where renters pay on average 30% of their income on rent (County and Non-Profit owned).

Eviction Prevention Coordinator, Oxford County Supports Oxford County RGI tenants through advocacy, mediation, and negotiation to prevent eviction and maintain housing.

- Available through internal Human Services referral

Transitional Housing

Supportive, temporary accommodation, that bridges the gap from homelessness to permanent housing.

Supportive Housing

Permanent, affordable housing that provides support services to help residents live more stable lives.
